4.) Summary of Improvements/Mitigation Conducted during 2024

In 2023 all water sources were tested for lead in accordance with OAR 333-061-0400 and OAR 581-022-2223. The full report is available on our website here: <u>https://sherwoodcharterschool.org/resources/#1540839922107-ba0ac812-bdf8</u> All results were below 20ppb, the EPA MCL (maximum contaminant level) for lead in public drinking water.

In March 2024 we re-tested 2 water sources. Both came back under the threshold, but higher than zero. Signage was posted that the water was not for drinking and it was scheduled to be retested in 2025.

We had limited pesticide applications or mitigation in 2024. We had 2 pesticide applications: weed control on April 19th and yellow jackets on September 20th. Information on the pesticides used can be found at the link below:
